OVERVIEW

The Supply Chain Project Manager serves a critical role in Eden Labs' product manufacturing ensuring Eden Labs GMP compliant production meets quality, cost, and delivery timing expectations.

Supervises in-house Production team as well as the Shipping and Receiving Coordinator ensuring an accurate parts inventory is always maintained.

PRIMARY PRODUCTION PROJECT MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervise the Warehouse Shipping/Receiving Coordinator and the on-site Production Team:
 - Communicate and assign projects (e.g. System Orders, On Demand Parts / Service Support, Research and Design, etc.);
 - Develop and assign project tasks to Production Team using PM.Com;
 - Ensure Production assignments are completed on time and according to plan.
- Review Sales Orders with Operations and Sales Representative to ensure accuracy.
 - Create System Project and assign tasks to Company team members in PM.com based on Sales Order.
- Develop testing protocols, production and shipping checklists, system packing slips for Systems to include associated Standard Operating Procedures.
- Maintain and supervise Company Supply Chain, Shipping, Receiving, Warehousing and distribution operations by initiating, developing, coordinating and enforcing program and operational policies and procedures.
- Provide reports and communications on demand for team/coworkers; especially Executives, Operations, Accounting, and Production Teams.
- Communicate with vendors, suppliers, and manufacturers to obtain pricing, quotes, and supply availability for all key materials, parts, and components.
- Maintain healthy and productive relationships with vendors, suppliers, and manufacturers by communicating expectations, issues, and re-order projections.
- Submit Purchase Order for key materials, parts, and components to Accounting as necessary.
- Maintain an accurate production timing calendar with consistent production check-ins communicating any delays directly to the sales coordinator.
- Ensure all records are organized and accessible for review and audits in appropriate format(s), e.g. hard copy, electronic..
- Coordinate and prepare packing lists for System Shipping.
- Develop Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), including required GMP Quality Control checklists.

- BS Degree in Supply Chain, Engineering, Business Management, Operations, Information Technology, and coursework viewed favorably. Advanced degree a plus.
- PMP Certification a plus.
- Extensive knowledge/use of Project Management system such as PM.com
- Continuous Improvement experience with knowledge and practical application of multiple methodologies (Lean, Six Sigma, Kaizen, Kanban, etc.) preferred.

- Working knowledge of pipe, tube, fittings, valves, instrumentation, and equipment.
- Proficient in the use of inventory specific or other database software, Quickbooks Inventory Pro.
- Comfortable in a dynamic work environment and flexible with changes in the business.
- Positive, solution oriented, attitude and approach to job and work environment.
- Must be organized, positive, proactive, and results-oriented.
